Tim Lynch comes to Lakewood from his most recent pastorate at Sweet Home Baptist Church in Guntersville, Alabama, where he served for over six years. Previously, he has served at churches in Deep Gap & Supply, North Carolina and Gadsden, Alabama. He has 20 years experience in the ministry.

Tim is a graduate of The College at Southeastern Seminary with a degree in Biblical Studies. He is presently studying for his Master of Divinity at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary.

Through that message the Lord convicted me and showed me that I was not truly saved. That day I surrendered my life to Christ and God saved me. Ever since that day, my life has been different and it's amazing at what the Lord can do by His grace. Shortly after that I was called to vocational ministry. God has given me the privilege to serve churches as youth pastor and as senior pastor.

I have a great burden to see the lost come to know Christ as Savior and Lord. I also have a burden to see our churches preaching the true Word of God. There are too many men out there preaching their own opinion instead of standing firm on God's word. My heart is to stay faithful to God and His Word by preaching expositional through a text.

My heart is with the local church and that is where God has put me to serve. I love the local church and I love being with the people of God. It is a great privilege to serve the local church and to seek to make disciples. My goal for people is that they will Know Christ and Make Him Known.
